Aim:	The fund aims to deliver returns in line with the benchmark, while looking to achieve carbon intensity of at least 30% lower than that of the Index and considering a company's ability and willingness to transition and contribute to a lower carbon economy.

From time to time, the fund may invest in cash and other investments the manager considers appropriate. Responsible investment, and environmental, social and governance insights are incorporated into the investment process.

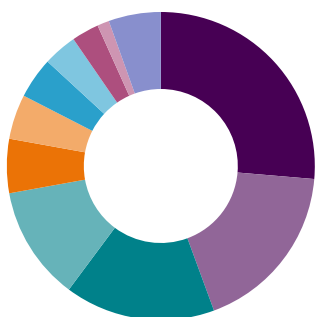
